Three-day residency @ le Centre des Livres d' Artistes (CDLA) hosted by Didier Mathieu  
Thurs. 8<sup>th</sup> to Sun. 11<sup>th</sup> September 2022

- Walks, L'Auvezère - Documentation/ reflection, public event, Anliac (Sat. 10<sup>th</sup>)
- Walks, documentation/ reflection - Collective recollection, CDLA (Sun. 11<sup>th</sup> until 4pm)

We arrive with our experience and notes from preliminary fieldwork ([Walking in Air 'de chez soi'](#), 16<sup>th</sup>/ 19<sup>th</sup> Sept 2021) and having read Tim Ingold's article "*Footprints through the weather-world: walking, breathing, knowing*". For the individual/collective walks, we may choose to use the following prompts, prompts of our own choosing, or none at all.

'To wander is literally to wind along.' (Tim Ingold, 2010)

'Make a way for the wind.' (Yoko Ono, 1962)

'In the wind Time walks.' (Nanao Sakaki (1980)

'A textual nimbus, air born' (Peter Gizzi, 2016)

The public event on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> September is at Leni's house in Anliac as an informal sharing and telling of some of our past or recent *Walking in Air* traces and stories (score, text, sound/ video work, discussion).

These will be uploaded on the project and CDLA website.

The CDLA will publish documentation of the three days in pamphlet form.

*Drawing on Tim Ingold's suggestion that 'knowledge is formed along paths of movement in the weather-world', the Walking in Air project considers walking in air to be a model for speculative thinking, for creative activity and for reconsidering our place within the natural environment. The co-organisers are Will Montgomery (Royal Holloway, University of London) and Emmanuelle Waeckerlé (University for the Creative Arts, Farnham). Participants are drawn from an international pool of composers, artists, and poets.*
